Visiting Indigenous Scholar Fellowship

In response to the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's calls to action, the Faculty of Humanities is establishing a fellowship for a Visiting Indigenous Scholar to be appointed to the faculty each year. The fellowship this year is valued at \$10,000, and the successful candidate will be provided with an office and staff support. The fellowship is for one semester (either Fall 2016 or Spring 2017), but may be spread over two semesters at the candidate's discretion.

The successful applicant will normally be expected to deliver a Faculty of Humanities lecture, provide advice to the Dean and the various departments of the Faculty, give occasional class lectures related to the candidate's area of expertise, and provide advice to students and faculty. To launch the project in the academic year 2016-2017, the Faculty is partnering with the SSHRC-funded project "Asian Canadians on Vancouver Island: Race, Indigeneity, and the Transpacific" (PI, John Price, History) and the successful applicant will be expected to act as an advisor for this project with additional responsibilities in the Faculty of Humanities to be negotiated. The successful candidate will hold a PhD related to Indigenous Studies, have a demonstrated capacity to teach and publish in the field, and be willing to work with a diverse group of faculty and students. This year, specialized knowledge in the history and society of Indigenous peoples of Vancouver Island will be an additional asset.
