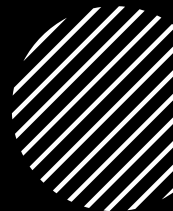

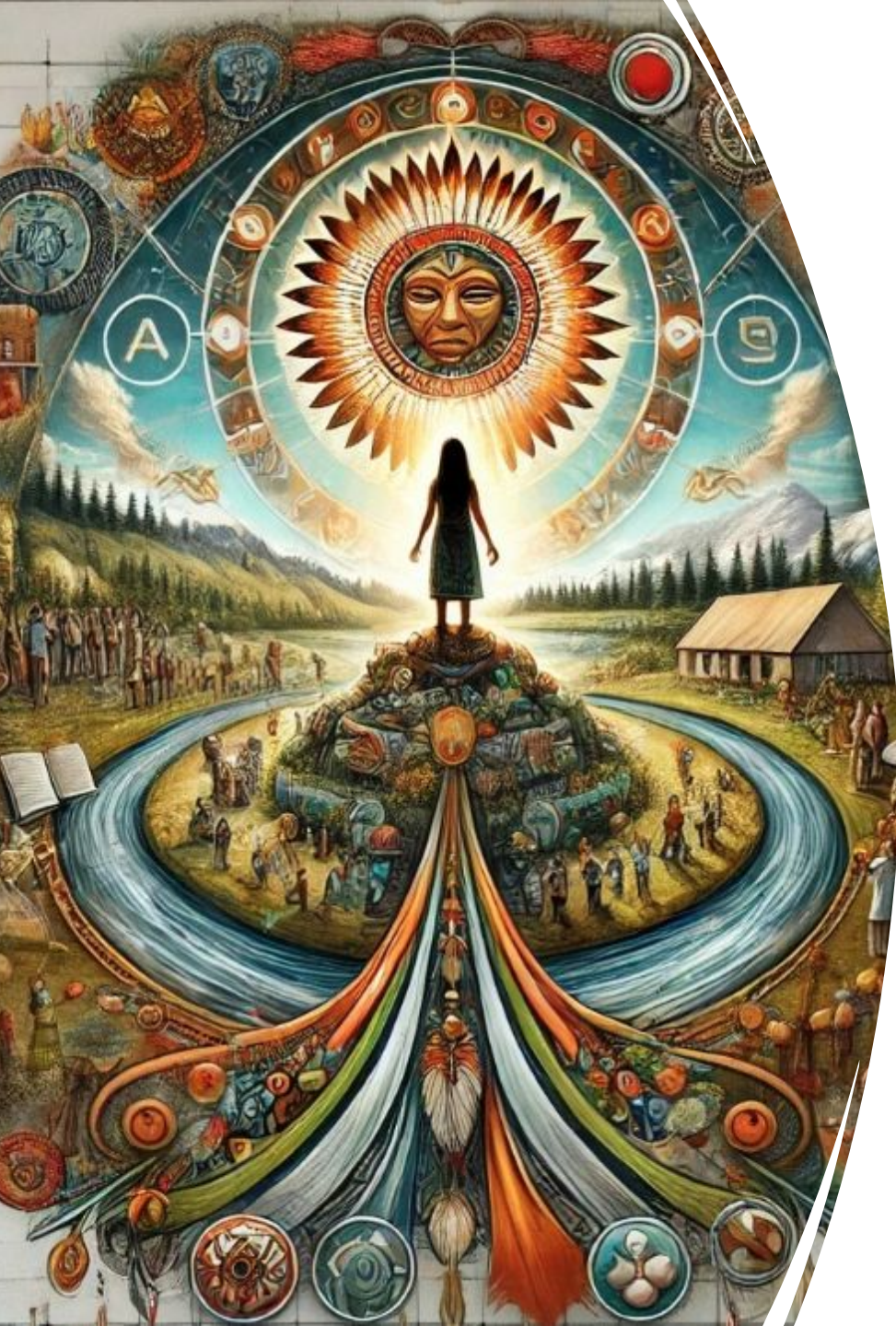

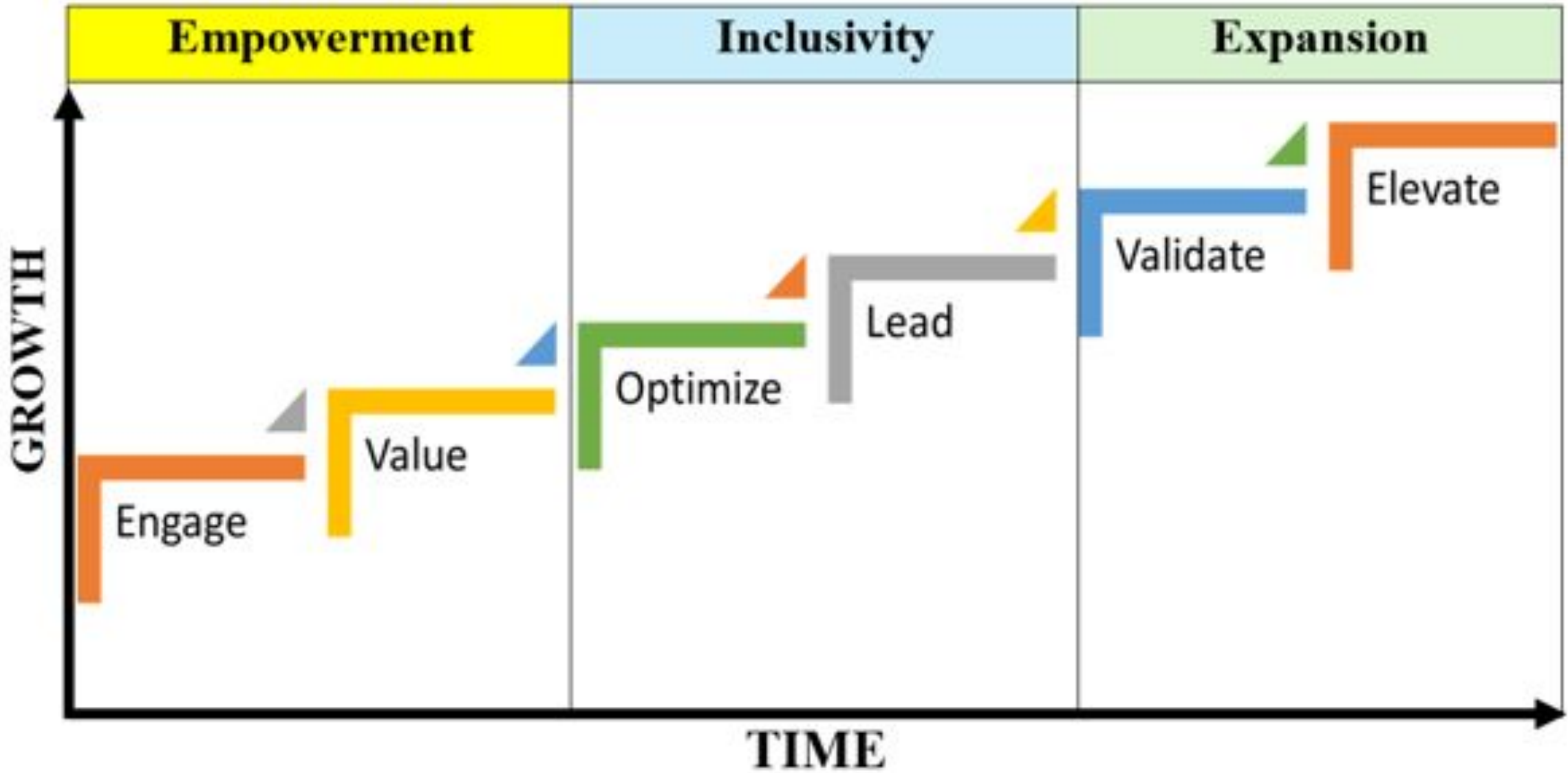
Inclusivity

- aims to Optimize and improve systems and practices to ensure they are inclusive and equitable, with leaders consistently championing these practices as part of the culture.

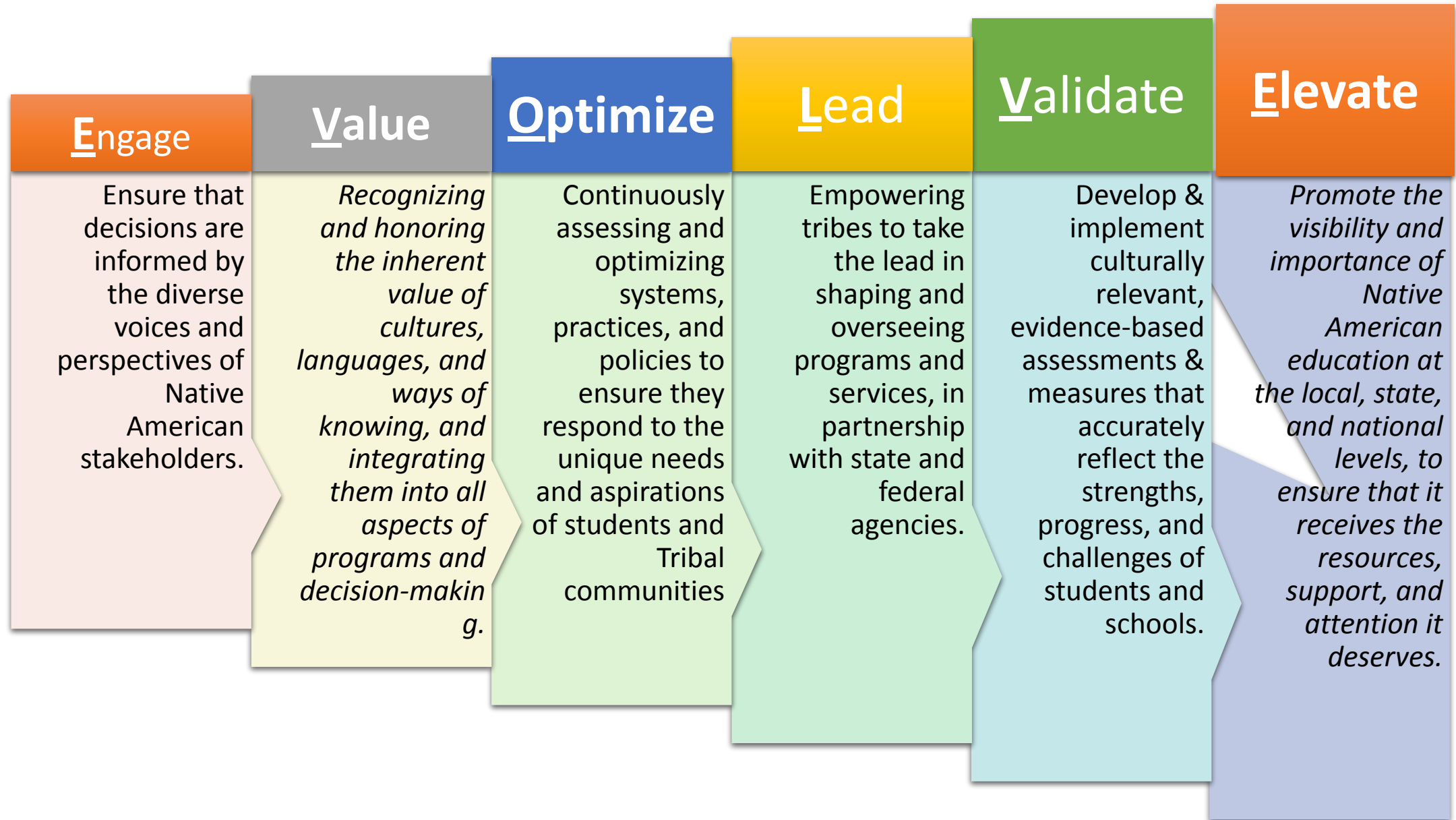
Expansion
