#2 UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE & ARTS (CHICKASHA, OKLAHOMA)

The student would receive \$4,831 back from the school, which can be used to pay for books and miscellaneous expenses. This is before any internal scholarship are applied. The minimum USAO academic scholarship is the Green & the Gold, which provides \$1,000 toward tuition and of 3.6 and a 21 ACT score. The university also provides scholarships for students who are children of educators, musically inclined, and more.

Cost of attendance for a student who does not receive federal/state aid based on income is dependent on a variety of factors including GPA, ACT score, tribal higher education funding, etc.

#3 NORTHWESTERN OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY (ALVA, OKLAHOMA)

This is too much to return to a student, so even if both the FSEOG and OTAG grants were dropped, the student would still receive \$1,990 back to pay for books and miscellaneous expenses.

The minimum NWOSU academic scholarship is \$500 for a 3.0 GPA and 21 ACT score. The university also provides scholarships for the President's Leadership Class and more.

Cost of attendance for a student who does not receive federal and/or state aid based on family income is dependent on a variety of factors including their GPA and ACT score, acceptance into the President's Leadership Class, what level of higher education funding their tribe provides, etc.
