Remember that even if a college has a high Indigenous population (most colleges have less than 1%), they may not have an active Native population such as a student association, cultural events, etc., or have defined support systems on campus. Many colleges have large Native populations due primarily to their proximity to Tribal communities. Numerous colleges listed here have Native student associations on campus.
