Dual Programs



Here are three regional cooperative programs for students who want to attend a small college, but also want access to big university opportunities.

Manhattan Christian College and Kansas State University have a cooperative agreement where students of Manhattan Christian College can also take classes and use facilities at Kansas State University, just down the road. Both schools are located in Manhattan, Kansas.

Haskell Indian Nations University and the University of Kansas (located in Lawrence, Kansas) have cooperative agreements which provide HINU students with academic and facility access to the University of Kansas, only two miles from the Haskell campus. The bonus is that classes at KU are free to HINU students.

Ozark Christian College and Missouri Southern State University in Joplin, Missouri have a long-standing cooperative degree program so that students at the Ozark Christian College can benefit from the larger facilities and degree offerings of Missouri Southern

State University located nearby.
Ozark Christian
College is less than a 20-minute drive from the Oklahoma border.
